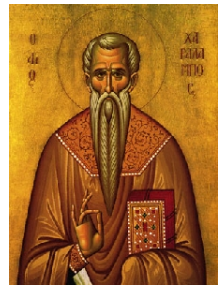

#### **SUNDAY OF PASCHA**

Midnight THE RESURRECTION – After the proclamation of the Resurrection outside the Church, the real celebration of our Lord's Resurrection will occur in the Divine Liturgy inside the Church from 12:15 – 2:00 (Holy Communion).

Morning Vespers of Love – 11:00 – 12:30 at St Eustathios Church presided over by his Grace Bishop Ezekiel.

PLEASE when coming for Holy Communion be modestly dressed, come during the time of the Service, and don't wear lipstick as this sticks to the Holy Spoon and also stains the Communion cloth.

Please prepare yourselves spiritually for Holy Communion with prayer, fasting and confession.

ALSO, please be careful where you park your car so as not to upset our neighbours and also to avoid being fined.

You are also reminded that the use of fire-crackers etc is not only impious and disrespectful but also illegal.

Those wanting to give a donation towards buying flowers for the Epitaphio may do so at the Church. This will enable us to buy flowers of the same type and the required colours so that the decoration of the Epitaphios will be of the highest quality.
